

## **Explanation of the Game of the Day for 2018 Season**

### **General Reminders**

- Always exchange score cards at the first tee
- Always bring your own score card to record your own score
- Some of you may like to get into habit of recording the number of putts you had on each hole.
- At the end of nine holes it is a good idea to confirm with your fellow players if all the score cards agree. If there's a mistake it is easier to catch after nine holes of play as opposed to 18.

### **(1) April 03, 2018 and April 10, 2018 Regular Golf**

These two games are pre-season. The season officially starts on April 17, 2018. The draw will be completed by getting all the names of those who signed up manually or electronically. The names will be placed in a hat and selected randomly. There will be no scoring by the Draw Committee. The Draw Committee will prepare the scorecards and leave them in the pro shop. The purpose of these two games is to be very casual. Also if we have anyone who would like to play to see what it's all about then hopefully this will give them an idea if they would like to join for the season.

### **(3) April 17, 2018 Scramble on Opening Day**

*PLEASE REMEMBER TO WEAR YOUR PINK GOLF SHIRT FOR CLUB COLOURS DAY.*

This is a shotgun start at 0830. After completing our round there will be a luncheon served. As well, Marilyn Carter will be there to collect cheques. If you wish to participate in the regular games as well as the tournaments etc. the total cost is \$42.00. You will be asked when you sign-up whether you would like Quiche Lorraine or Vegetarian Quiche. The lunch will be charged to your account.

The Draw Committee will prepare the scorecard for each team. Everyone will tee off. Then the team members choose the best of the four shots. **IF YOUR BALL IS SELECTED YOU DO NOT HIT THAT SHOT.** Then you proceed to the next shot and follow the same procedure. Once the ball has reached the green, all four players take one putt. If not holed out, please pick up the ball. This means you should not count more than two putts per hole. Each player **MUST** have their drive chosen at least three times.

Please leave your scorecard with the Draw Committee and the best team will be determined.

**(4) April 24, 2018 Fewest Putts**

The Toonie Pot for this week is KP #9.

This is an individual game and therefore will be flighted. Each person will have their own scorecard. Scorecards will be exchanged at the first tee. Please keep your own score so you can enter your own score into the computer for handicap purposes. Your gross score will be recorded on each hole as well as the number of putts you had on each hole. There are to be NO conceded putts.

The Draw Committee will determine the winners with the fewest putts in each of the flights.

**(5) May 01, 2018 4 Ball Match Play**

Toonie Pot is closest to the line.

Each foursome will have two teams. Each team will either be playing on behalf of Pebble Beach or Augusta. The first person listed in the foursome will keep score, please keep your individual score for posting purposes. Each player will play to the lowest handicap in the group. For example, if the lowest handicap in the group is 20 and if the other players are 24, 25 and 27 then the person with the 20 handicap would have to "give" her other team members 4, 5 and 7 strokes respectively.

The Draw Committee will determine the winning team.

**(6) May 08, 2018 Tax Break**

Toonie Pot will KP #9 & #17.

This is an individual flighted game. Net score less three strokes for each actual (gross) par or better.

For example, assume a player has a GROSS score of 100 and has a 30 handicap. Their net score would be 70. Assume as well they had two pars, say a three on nine and a four on 14. They would take 70 and subtract 6 to bring their final score for the purposes of this game to 64.

**(7) May 15, 2018, Nickels Skins**

Toonie Pot is KP # 9 and longest drive.

This is a team game. The captain of each team will bring a "baggie" for the nickels.

Please remember to bring 18 nickels with you. At the start of each hole, each player puts a nickel in the bag provided. This is a four player match, played off the lowest handicap in the group. See explanation under 4 Ball Match Play. The NET winner of a hole wins the skin and the four nickels. If there is a tie the "pot" is carried forward to the next hole. If tied after 18, split the pot.

**(8) May 22, 2018 Three Blind Mice**

*PLEASE WEAR YOUR PINK GOLF SHIRT AS THIS IS CLUB COLORS DAY.*

Luncheon will be served after the game.

Toonie Pot is KP #9.

This is an individual flighted game. Three holes will be arbitrarily chosen by the pro shop. The scores on those holes will not count. Lowest net score in each flight will win.

**(9) May 29, 2018 Beat the Champ**

Toonie Pot is closest to the line.

If you would like to participate in this game, you must include \$1.00 in your registration fee. The money collected goes toward Junior Development Programs.

If your net score is better than the Champ's net score in the 2017 Provincial Amateur Championship, you will have beaten the Champ.

Because this is a pin and putts round please record all your putts.

**(10) June 5, 2018 Team Stableford**

Toonie Pot is KP #9 & #17.

This is a team game. The team captain will keep the Stableford scores. Please keep track of your own scores for posting.

Stableford Scoring:

1 point for NET bogey

2 points for NET par

3 points for NET birdie

4 points for NET eagle

5 points for NET double eagle

The best 2 Stableford scores will be used on each hole.

**(11) June 12, 2018 Dorothy Olive Franklin Day**

Toonie Pot is closest to the line.

The Dorothy Olive Franklin is a BC Golf competition. The entry fee is \$2.00 and proceeds go towards Junior Girls golf in B.C. One prize will be awarded to each Zone Low Net Differential winner. The ARLGC lowest net score for the day will be submitted to Zone 5 for contention.

This is a regular game of golf. It is an individual game of golf. It will be flighted and the fewest putts will determine the winner of each flight.

Because this is a pin and putts round please record your putts on your scorecard.

**(12) July 03, 2018 Four Ball/ Best Two Net**

Toonie Pot is KP #9.

This is a team game.

The Captain keeps the team's score. Each player keeps track of their own score for posting. For purposes of this game, count the two lowest net scores on each hole.

**(13) July 10, 2018 Criss Cross**

Toonie Pot is KP #9 and longest drive.

This is an individual game. Players elect to take the score from either the hole on the front nine or the back nine. For example, your score on 1 or 10, 2 or 11, 3 or 12 etc.

Because you will only have a nine hole score, to determine your final score you take your GROSS score minus  $\frac{1}{2}$  of your handicap.

This is a pin and putts round. Please record all your putts.

**(14) July 31, 2018 Team Various Pars**

Toonie Pot is KP #9 & #17.

This is a team game. On EACH par 5 you take the one lowest net score. On EACH par 4 you take the two lowest net scores. On EACH par 3 you take the three lowest net scores.

**(15) August 07, 2018 T's & F's**

Toonie pot is closest to the line.

This is an individual game. Players will be flighted. Play round as usual. However, for purposes of this game, only count your NET score for each hole that starts with a T or an F. T's would be third, tenth, thirteenth and twelfth. F's would be first, fourth, fifth, fourteenth, and fifteenth.

**(16) August 14, 2018 Low Gross Flighted**

Toonie Pot is KP #9.

This is an individual game. Record gross scores. No putts conceded.

This is also pin and putts round #5.

All putts must be recorded.

**(17) August 21, 2018 Team Match Play**

Toonie pot is KP #9 and closest to the pin.  
See May 01, 2018 explanation above.

**(18) August 28, 2018 Hate'em**

Toonie pot is KP #9 & #17.  
This is an individual game. Players are flighted. At the first tee, circle the two holes you hate the most. You must select one hole on the front and one hole on the back. After play, subtract your selected "hate'em" holes from your gross score. Enter "true" score in the computer.

**(19) September 04, 2018 Team Stableford**

Toonie pot is closest to the line.  
See June 15, 2018 for an explanation of this game.

**(20) September 11, 2018 Individual Low Net**

Toonie Pot is KP #9.  
This is an individual game. No putts are to be conceded. Individuals will be flighted.  
This is pin round #6.

**(21) September 25, 2018 Nickel Skins**

Toonie pot is KP #9.  
This is a team game. The captain of each team will bring a "baggie" for the nickels.

Please remember to bring 18 nickels with you. At the start of each hole, each player puts a nickel in the bag provided. This is a four player match, played off the lowest handicap in the group. See explanation under 4 Ball Match Play. The NET winner of a hole wins the skin and the four nickels. If there is a tie the "pot" is carried forward to the next hole. If tied after 18, split the pot.
