

## **PROTOCOL FOR SCORE CARD SUBMISSION FOR THE 2020 AR18HLG**

The following protocols have been developed by the Draw Team to deal with the issue of score card submissions on Tuesdays and to keep handling of score cards to a minimum and ensure continued social distancing after your golf game on Tuesday.

Your patience, understanding, and observance of the new protocols, as a result of COVID-19, is very much appreciated.

1. Score cards will be made up by the Draw Team and left in the pro shop for pick up by each Captain before play on Tuesday morning.
2. The prepared single score card will be used every Tuesday to record the hole-by-hole score of each player.
3. The Captain will record their groups' scores on the single score card and at the end of the game, deposit the score card in the plastic bag left on the table in the ladies' locker room.
4. This single score card will be the official record of the Game of the Day.
5. Individuals will keep their own score cards in order that the hole-by-hole score can be input into the Golf Canada registry for handicap purposes – Dierdre will still be checking to ensure that golfers playing on Tuesday's input their golf scores on a **hole-by-hole** basis.

Please do not hand in your individual score card – it is yours to keep.

6. Winners of Game of the Day will not necessarily be announced on the same day as play, but via email as quickly as logistics permit.
7. For the 2020 ARLGC season, prizes will be given out for the Game of the Day winners using a point system for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners. Details on the points system will be provided later.
