

“Game of the Day” Glossary - 2021 Season

General reminders

During COVID-19

- Groups of 3 players will be the norm.
- For *individual* games, a scorecard will be given to you by the Draw Committee.
 - A second individual scorecard is also required (see below re *all* games).
 - At the end of the game, sign your scorecard, and place it in the wooden box on the table in the ladies’ locker room.
- For *team* games, the team captain will be given a scorecard by the Draw Committee, and then keeps score for all players.
 - The captain will be required to keep two scorecards (team and self); all other team members will only be required to keep one card (see below re *all* games).
 - At the end of the game, the team captain will sign the scorecard and place it in the wooden box on the table in the ladies’ locker room.
- For *all* games, keep your own score on a separate scorecard, so that you can enter your score into the Golf Canada handicap system, hole by hole, after your round. (This card is *not* submitted.)
- DO NOT exchange score cards!
 - For *individual* games, keep the score for one other player on *your* scorecard, and verbally confirm their score after each hole.

Putting

- Per Golf Canada rules for competitions and posting for handicaps, all holes **must** be putted out ... *no conceded putts*. If you choose to pick up (for COVID-19 concerns or any other reason), you are still eligible to play with Tuesday Ladies; but you will *not* be eligible for prizes. The *only* exceptions are:
 - Match play games; or
 - If specifically allowed under the Game of the Day rules

Handicap Groupings

- Teams will be made up either by mixing handicaps or equalizing handicaps, meaning the sum of the handicaps for the teams will be as close together as possible. It is seldom literally ‘equal’

Deuce Pot - \$2

- Prizes will be given for scoring a two on a hole.
- Deuce pot rules (all holes or specified holes) are listed on the Fixture List.
- Participation is voluntary.
- If participating, sign up each Tuesday in the Pro Shop and deposit your toonie in the box.

Posting Scores

- Golf Canada’s new handicap rules:
 - Scores are to be posted on *the day of play* (so that playing conditions can be assessed and possibly adjusted).

- Please post scores using the *hole-by-hole* method, with your *actual* score. (The system will automatically adjust to your maximum hole limit).

Prize Awards

- Individual game winners will receive 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd and 1 points for 3rd. Payouts will be made at the Closing event to Credit Book.
- Tournament game winners will receive credit book prizes after the tournament. Trophies are awarded at the Closing event.

Tee times will be assigned, unless a Shotgun Start is indicated.

April 20	Two Best Net	Team game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equalized handicaps set by Draw Committee • Each player plays their own ball • Two best net scores on each hole count for the game score • Payouts based on lowest two best net scores
April 27	Low Gross Flighted Pin & Putts # 1	Individual game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payouts based on low gross score by flight Pin Round <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “A nationally sponsored stroke play competition, less full handicap, to be played on the member club course under the same conditions on specific days.” – BC Golf • Pins are awarded annually to the player returning the lowest aggregate of 4 net scores, and to the runner up. • Only Golf Canada members are eligible to receive this award. • Participation is voluntary; to take part, pay \$2 along with your annual registration. Putts Competition: (in house competition) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals will need to track the number of putts. • Based on the least number of puts in 3 out of 5 rounds.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winner receives the Captain's Trophy • <i>Note: a putt is defined as any stroke taken on the green.</i> Example: Jane is on the green in 3 strokes. Her first putt rolls off the green; she chips back for her 5th stroke; and takes 2 more strokes on the green to hole out. The total number of putts is 3
May 4	9 Hole – 3 clubs only Aeration Day	Individual game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players selects 3 clubs to use for the whole game • Prize of sleeve of balls to best net score (use half handicap) • Score cannot be posted to Golf Canada
May 11	Low Net Flighted Pin & Putts # 2	Individual game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mixed teams • Payouts based on low net score by flight • See April 27 for Pin & Putts discussion
May 18	Eclectic Tournament – Day 1	Individual game A 2-day tournament, playing for the Crystal Bowl Trophy.
May 25	Eclectic Tournament – Day 2 8:30 Shotgun, followed by Lunch Club Colours Day – Wear your blue shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After both rounds are played, the lowest gross score for each hole is used to calculate an 18-hole total, before handicap. • Gross score to be posted to Golf Canada for both rounds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Post as a regular round, not as a Tournament round! • Payouts for lowest overall net score
June 1	Beat the Champ Beat the Pro Low net flighted	3 separate individual games in 1! Beat the Champ <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A round of golf played during the month of June, raising funds in support of Provincial Junior Golf development • Your lowest <i>NET</i> score vs. the lowest <i>GROSS</i> score of the reigning BC Women's Amateur Champion • Participation is voluntary; to take part, pay \$1 along with your annual registration. Beat the Pro <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beat our club pro by hitting closer to the pin on #9 than the pro! • Mark "Y" or "N" on scorecard! • Prize to be drawn from all "Y" entries. Low Net <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payouts based on low net score by flight
June 8	Team Stableford	Team game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equalized handicaps, set by Draw Committee • Scoring is based on points awarded for birdie, par, bogey, etc. • Payouts based on total of two highest Stableford scores by hole
June 15	Dorothy Olive Franklin Low net flighted Pin & Putts # 3	Individual game Dorothy Olive Franklin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A round of golf raising funds in support of Junior Girls Golf development. • There will be 1 Zone 5 winner and 1 Provincial winner. • Participation is voluntary; to take part, pay \$2 along with your annual registration. • See April 27 for Pin & Putts discussion

June 22	Diamond Stableford Tournament – Day 1	<p>Team game</p> <p>A 2-day tournament, playing for the Thunderbird Trophy.</p>
June 29	Diamond Stableford Tournament– Day 2 8:00 Shotgun, followed by Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equalized handicaps, set by Draw Committee • Scoring is based on points awarded for birdie, par, bogey, etc. • Gross score to be posted to Golf Canada for both rounds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Post as a regular round, not as a Tournament round! • Payouts for highest Stableford points
July 6	Low Net Flighted Pin & Putts # 4	<p>Individual game</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payouts based on low net score by flight • See April 27 for Pin & Putts discussion
July 13	Team Match Play	<p>Team game</p> <p>The field will be divided into two teams – Team Lotte and Team Meijer. (tournaments won by Brooke Henderson last year) Each foursome will consist of two players for each team.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four ball match play. <i>See Rule 23</i> • Two competitors play as partners, each playing her own ball. • One point per hole is won by the team whose member has the lowest net score. • If the hole is tied, each team gets ½ a point • Each player will play to the lowest handicap of the group and will get strokes on holes based on this handicap differential. • Full 18-hole score is posted to Golf Canada. • Payouts awarded to all players on best team (Lotte vs Meijer)
July 20	Senior / Super Senior Tournament Day 1	<p>Individual game</p> <p>A 36-hole stroke play tournament for the Dogwood Cup (Net), the Whale Trophy (Gross), and the Golden Girl Trophy (low net for members 70+ years).</p>
July 27	Senior / Super Senior Tournament Day 2 8:00 Shotgun, followed by Lunch Club Colours Day – Wear your blue shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gross score to be posted to Golf Canada for both rounds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Post as Tournament rounds!
August 3	Bingo, Bango, Bongo	<p>Individual game</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 point is awarded for being first “in regulation” ... first to hit a shot onto the green (Bingo), closest to the pin with shot onto the green (Bango), and first to hole out (Bongo). Group winner has the most points at the end of 18 holes! • Honours to be observed throughout the round ... including teeing off on par 3s. • Payouts to highest points winners
August 10	Fewest Putts Pins & Putts #5	<p>Individual game</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lowest number of putts through 18 holes • See April 27 for Pin & Putts discussion

August 17	Two Best Net	Team game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equalized handicaps, set by Draw Committee • Each player plays their own ball • Two best net scores on each hole count for the game • Payouts based on lowest two best net scores
August 24	Individual Stableford	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mixed teams • Scoring is based on points awarded for birdie, par, bogey, etc. • Payouts based on highest Stableford score
August 26 THURSDAY	Mens' and Ladies' Intraclub Match 8:00 Shotgun, followed by Lunch	Team game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sign-up will be posted on the website • 2 women players against 2 men players. • Match play – <i>see Rule 23</i> • Details to be provided with score cards.
August 31	Foursomes	Team game – choose your own partner 2 person teams playing alternate shots. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Score can <i>not</i> be posted to Golf Canada. • Payouts based on lowest net team score
September 7	Low Gross Flighted Pin # 6	Individual game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See April 27 for Pin discussion • Payouts based on low gross score by flight
September 14	Team Low Net 123	Team game The team score consists of 3 low net score on par 3s, 2 low net scores on par 4s, and 1 low net scores on par 5s. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payouts for lowest team score
September 21	Closing Day 9 Holes, followed by Lunch & AGM Meeting & Awards Club Colours Day – Wear your blue shirt	Individual game AGM AWARDS DAY
September 28	No organized game, but available for those not playing Zone 5 Foursomes
