

**Arbutus Ridge Ladies Club  
Executive Committee Meeting Minutes  
September 15, 2016**

Meeting called to order at 9:05 am

1. Approval of August 11, 2016 Executive Meeting Minutes – M/S Marilyn Carter/Myra Jones
2. Business Arising from the Minutes: Marg reported she had contacted Strata regarding the AGM and was informed June 21<sup>st</sup> is a Wednesday so would not co-inside with Ladies Day – however this date should be kept in mind when planning Interclub events.
3. Captain's Report – Marg Graham
  - Correspondence was received from Barbara Bertagnolli advising that according to the 1999 Ladies booklet a chip-in made during an interclub match at home or away should be counted for our Ladies Club chip-in award. Also she suggested we consider moving the Net Tournament into the Eclectic Tournament dates and that the Net Tournament should be played on a Tuesday/Thursday rather than Tuesday/Tuesday.
    - Response from Deirdre:  
“Regarding "Ladies Day Competition"...in most clubs, it refers to the regular weekly day one plays in a ladies' league (we play Tuesdays, some have Business Ladies groups that play on a Saturday or Wednesday night). So, chip-ins and birdies would be on whichever day you play.  
Interclub is a separate competition and sign up, as well as played on a different day than the Tuesday, therefore would not be part of that “Ladies Day Competition”. Of course, birdies made at AR during an interclub match, could still be put on the ringer board.”
  - The Executive Committee agreed with Deirdre regarding the chip-in question and the dates for the 2017 tournaments will be considered by Myra and Virginia as they prepare the 2017 Fixture List. Marg will respond directly to Barbara.
  - Correspondence was received from Carol Grant enquiring if she qualified for a Break 100 Pin even though she had previously broken 100 at her golf club in Regina.
  - Marg will advise Carol that break pins are only awarded for the first time a player breaks 100, 90, 80, etc.
  - Congratulations to Sheena Nelson for Breaking 100. She will receive her BCGA pin at the Awards Banquet in October.

As you saw from Marg Roger's email, AR is being well represented this year by 5 teams.

#### 4. Vice Captain's Report – Virginia Goodings-Wolfe

- Interclub matches:
  - The two interclub matches between Cedar Hill and Arbutus Ridge took place on August 23rd at Cedar Hill and then August 31 at Arbutus Ridge. AR won both home and away matches for total points of 89 for Arbutus Ridge to 55 for Cedar Hill. After the final match at the Ridge, Joyce Carr, the organizer, mentioned that Cedar Hill may not be participating with us next year, as there are fewer ladies who sign up each year, and there are indications that some ladies would prefer to concentrate on clubs closer to home.
  - With reference to my last point above, I wouldn't mind soliciting the opinions of the ladies executive on Interclubs and how best to go forward. We may want to take it to the Ladies Club Membership as well. Questions are in the nature of: Should we post all Interclub match sign ups at the beginning of the year? Should we reduce or eliminate Interclubs due to lack of or diminished interest? If we do continue, what should we do about shirts (Cyndi and I have some thoughts)? To be brought forward at the AGM for the Ladies Club members to give some feedback.
- Chip ins:
  - Since our last meeting, there have been 6 chip-ins for a grand total of 83 chip ins so far this season. For your information, there is one person who has 4 chip-ins so far and 8 close behind with 3 chip-ins. There were no chip ins on holes 5 and 9. The most chip ins were on hole 2 with 8, followed by hole number 3 with 7. Holes 10 and 14 had 6 chip ins each.
- Birdies:
  - Since the last meeting there have been 12 birdies recorded for a grand total of 63 birdies this season. Just for your information, the person in the lead, who shall remain nameless except to herself and to Cyndi, who will prepare the final report for the AGM, right now has a total of 11 birdies. The person closest behind has 8 birdies. There were no birdies on 6 and 11. The most birdies were on hole number 9 at 15, followed by hole number 17 with 12.
- Ringer Board
  - The ringer board remains a regularly updated tool, and, again, I rely on the good services of Cyndi to finalize it prior to the AGM.

#### 5. Treasurer's Report – Marilyn Carter

- Paid out for draw prizes - \$542 with 2 weeks left (includes \$180 for pin rounds)

#### 7. Committee Reports

- Draw – Judy Huska
  - 2 regular season games since the last report – 1.2.3 cha cha cha and BINGO. Pin and Putt round #6 completed. Participation 20 - 24
  - Our team approach to doing the draw and scoring has been working well – thanks to all!
- Tournaments – Myra Jones
  - As a result of a very busy scheduling calendar, the Net Tournament was held two Tuesdays in a row, September 6th and 13th. It was extremely difficult to find a spot where we could do Tuesday and Thursday in the same week in September. We had 24 players each day, and one group of 4 “following the field” both days. The second day of play was a shotgun rather than tee times and I think this worked out well. Deirdre had provided a little rules quiz, with prizes, which occupied the ladies while waiting for the scoring to be completed, followed by a lovely lunch.
  - Our 1st Day Low Net player was Carol Grant with a 59. The winner of the Dogwood Cup also went to Carol Grant, with a two-day score of 130. Runner-up to Carol was Nancy Pidzamecky with one stroke more. Third and Fourth place winners went to Sheena Nelson and Heather Schyf. Kathy White was recognized as our Low Gross player with a two-day score of 178. I would like to thank the other committee members, Katie McFadden, Adele Manz and Chrisse Chandler. They were a great team and shared the tasks. A special thanks to Adele on her creative flower arrangements – they were outstanding.
